Tennessee Disclosure about Transferability of Credits

(Rule. 49-7-144)

Credits earned at Ohio Technical College may not transfer to another educational institution. Credits earned at another educational institution may not be accepted by Ohio Technical College. You should obtain confirmation that Ohio Technical College will accept any credits you have earned at another educational institution before you execute an enrollment contract or agreement. You should also contact any educational institutions that you may want to transfer credits earned at Ohio Technical College to determine if such institutions will accept credits earned at Ohio Technical College prior to executing an enrollment contract or agreement. The ability to transfer credits from Ohio Technical College to another educational institution may be very limited. Your credits may not transfer and you may have to repeat courses previously taken at Ohio Technical College if you enroll in another educational institution. You should never assume that credits will transfer to or from any educational institution. It is highly recommended and you are advised to make certain that you know the transfer of credit policy of Ohio Technical College and of any other educational institutions you may in the future want to transfer the credits earned at Ohio Technical College before you execute an enrollment contract or agreement.
